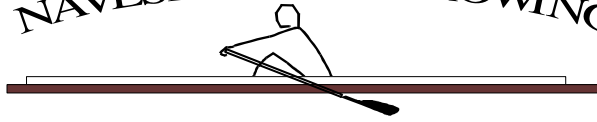

YOUTH PROGRAMS

___ Novice Youth Program: \$250

Two week (10-day) introduction to sculling for 14-18 year olds who have never rowed before. **Meets 10:45 AM to 12:30**

___ Intermediate Youth Program: 1 session \$200; 2 sessions \$400; 3 sessions \$500; 4 sessions \$600.

Two week (4 days/wk) program for youth (14-18) who have taken a "learn to row" program with at least 8 sessions on water.

Meets 8:45 – 10:30 AM M/T/W/TH Take 1, 2, 3, or all sessions ___ June 23–July 3 ___ July 7-17 ___ July 21–31 ___ Aug 4-14

___ Advanced Youth Program: \$500

Seven week (4 days/week) program for youth (14-19) who have rowed at the intermediate level or for at least one season in a High School program. Qualified athletes—based on ability/experience—will compete in area regattas (Their entry costs are *not* included in program fee.) **Meets 6:45-8:30 AM.** June 23 - August 9. **Boys:** M/W/F/S. **Girls:** T/TH/F/S.

___ **Fall Youth Program: \$300.** Youth at the intermediate level or above (as determined by past performance and/or coach's assessment) row from late August through October and compete in several "head" races. **Meet weekend mornings and one afternoon**—times to be announced.

ADULT LESSONS AND MEMBERSHIPS

(Must be 18 or older)

OPTIONS FOR SCULLING BEGINNERS

___ Adult Beginner Lessons: \$225

Four classes (2 hours each) in single sculls for adults with no previous sculling experience. Check website for lesson availability and note your 1st, 2nd, and 3rd choices at the top of this page.

___ **Adult Beginner Continuation: \$200.** A discounted boat use membership for adults who take 2008 beginner lessons. Includes one rowing lesson/orientation session and use of NRR boats/facilities for the rest of season.

___ **Additional family member(s)** who sign up for beginner continuation membership: \$100

OPTIONS FOR ADULTS WITH SCULLING EXPERIENCE

___ **Boat Use Membership: \$300*.** Use NRR shells and facilities; participate in NRR activities from May through October.

___ **Additional family member(s)** who sign up for boat use membership: \$150.

___ **Private Boat Owner Membership: \$175*** Store your shell and oars, use NRR facilities May thru October.

___ **Private Boat Owner-Plus Membership: \$225*** Includes occasional use of NRR boats/equipment.

___ **College Student Membership: \$200*** Use NRR boats and facilities while home from college for the summer.

___ **Additional family member(s)** who sign up for college student membership: \$100.

___ **Supporting Membership: \$35--**includes e-mail updates.

***\$20 off Boat Use, College Student, and both private boat owner memberships if paid by 5/1/2008. (One per family)**

IN CONSIDERATION of being given the opportunity to participate in any way in the Navesink River Rowing ("NRR"), United States Rowing Association sponsored activities ("Activity") I, for myself, my personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin:

1. ACKNOWLEDGE, agree, and represent that I understand the nature of Rowing Activities, both on the water and land based and that I am qualified, in good health, and in proper physical condition to participate in any Activity. **I FURTHER WARRANT that I have basic swimming skills.**

2. FULLY UNDERSTAND that: **(a)** ROWING ACTIVITIES INVOLVE RISKS AND DANGERS of serious bodily injury, including permanent disability, paralysis, and death ("risks"); **(b)** these risks may be caused by my own actions, or inactions, the actions of others participating in the Activity, the condition in which the Activity takes place, or the negligence of the "releasees" named below; **(c)** there may be other risks and social and economic losses either not known to me or not foreseeable at this time; and I FULLY ACCEPT AND ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS AND ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOSSES, COSTS, DAMAGES I incur as a result of my participation in any Activity.

3. AGREE AND WARRANT that I will examine and inspect each Activity in which I take part and that, if I observe any condition which I consider to be unacceptably hazardous or dangerous, I will notify the proper authority in charge and will refuse to take part in the Activity until the condition has been corrected.

4. HEREBY RELEASE, discharge, and covenant not to sue USRowing, Navesink River Rowing, their administrators, directors, agents, officers, volunteers and employees, other participants, any sponsors, advertisers, and, if applicable, owners and lessors of premises on which the Activity takes place (each considered one of the releasees herein) from all liability, claims, demands, losses, or damages on my account caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the releasees or otherwise, including negligent rescue operations; and I further agree that if, despite this release and waiver of liability, assumption of risk, and indemnity agreement, I, or anyone on my behalf, makes a claim against any of the releasees, I WILL INDEMNIFY, SAVE, AND HOLD HARMLESS each of the releasees from any litigation expenses, attorney fees, loss liability, damage, or cost which may incur as a the result of such a claim.

I have read this agreement, fully understand its terms, understand that I have given up substantial rights by signing it and have signed it freely and without any induction or assurance of any nature and intend it to be a complete and unconditional release of all liability to the greatest extent allowed by law and agree that if any portion of this
